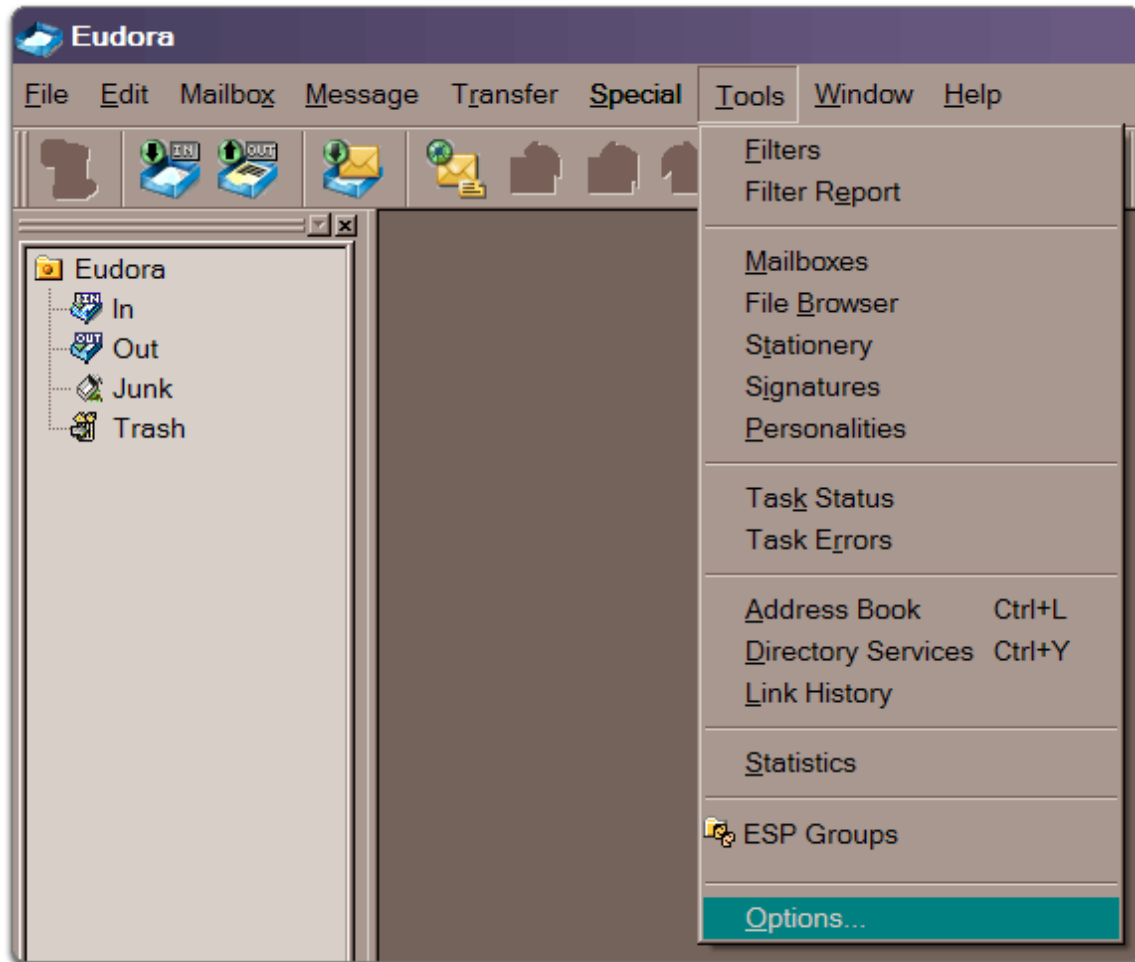


1. Open Eudora.
2. Click the 'Tools' menu, and select 'Options.'



3. Click 'Getting Started' under 'Category:.'

Enter your full name in the 'Real name:' field.

Enter your full email address (username@b2xonline.com) in the 'Return address:' field.

Enter 'mail.b2xonline.com' in the 'Mail Server (Incoming):' field.

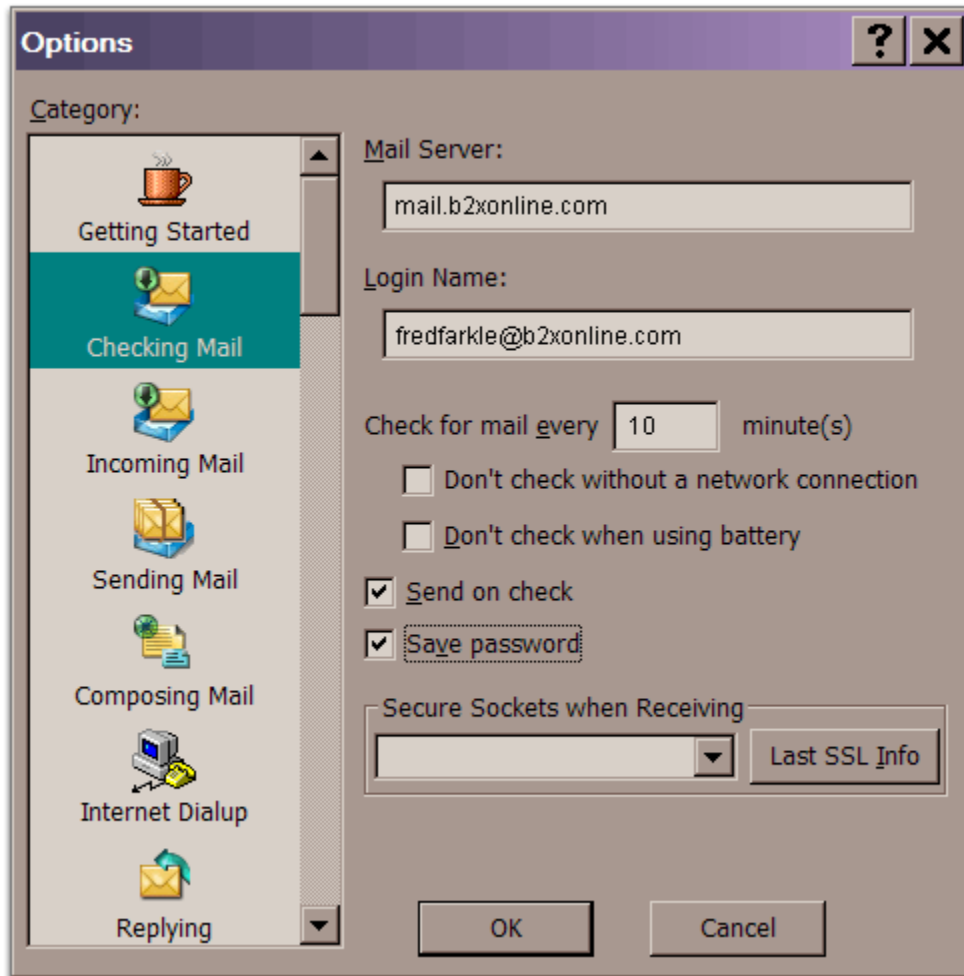
Enter your username (including '@b2xonline.com') in the 'Login Name' field.

Enter 'smtp.b2xonline.com' in the 'SMTP (Outgoing) Server:' field.

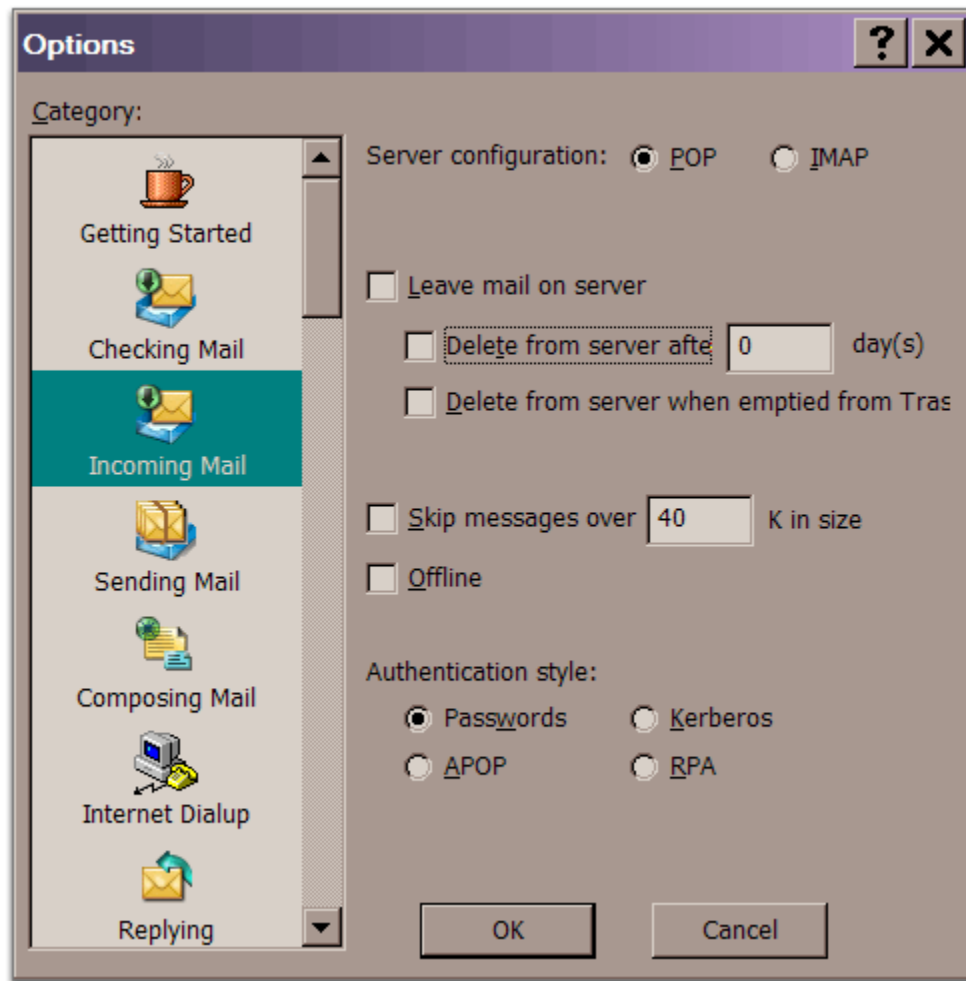
4. Click 'Checking Mail' under 'Category:.'



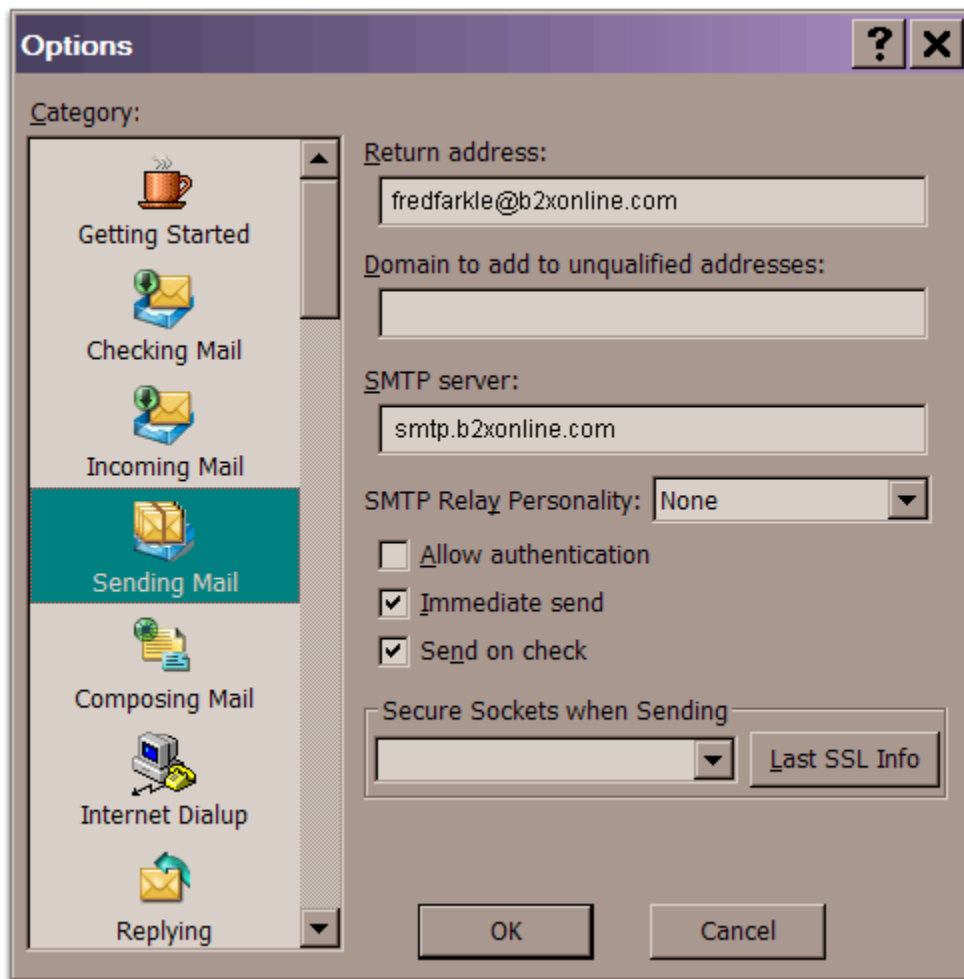
5. Click 'Incoming Mail' under 'Category:.'

6. Click 'Sending Mail' under 'Category:.'



7. Click 'OK,' and then verify your settings by clicking 'File,' and then 'Check Mail.'

8. You should have a new piece of mail from B2X Online. There are instructions on how to change your password and check your mail from any Internet connection via a web browser.
